According to Equibase, Tonito M. takes the win at Remington Park's 2014 Thoroughbred meet, paying out \$240,000 with one start, which he placed first. Place goes to Shanon Nicole, who payed out \$120,000 with one starts, placing first. Show belongs to Code West, with a \$105,000 pay out for placing first in his one and only start.

OHRC RULES OF RACING

325:50-1-3 ~ USE OF CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES OR PRESCRIPTION DRUGS

- (a) No person holding an occupation license issued by the Commission shall be under the influence of any scheduled "controlled dangerous substance" or synthetic substance as defined in the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substance Act, 63 O.S., §§ 2-101 through 2-606, or any other intoxicating substance within the enclosure of any racetrack under the control of the Commission.
- (b) The fact that any person charged with a violation of this Section is or has been lawfully entitled to use alcohol or a controlled dangerous substance or any other intoxicating substance shall not constitute a defense against any charge of violating this section.

OKLAHOMA DERBY HAD HEARTS RACING

Owned by M Racing Group LLC, and trained by Jerry Hollendorfer, **Tonito M.** took the **Grade 3, \$400,000 Oklahoma Derby** by 2-3/4 length in the final turn of the race under jockey Rafael Bejarno Sunday, September 28. In the **\$200,000 Remington Park Oaks**, **Shanon Nicole**, owned by Connie Apostelos and ridden by Rosie Napravnik, flew in to the stretch to finish with a 5-1/4 length victory. **Greengrassofyoming** took the win during the **\$100,000 Remington Green Stakes** under jockey Brian Hernandez Jr by 1-1/4 length. Greengrassofyoming is owned by Patricia's Hope LLC and trained by Mike Tomlinson.

Mico Margarita took the win in the **\$150,000 Remington Park Sprint Cup** under jockey Rosie Napravnik. Owned by J. Kirk Robison and trained by Steve Asmussen, Mico Maragrita won by a small 3/4 of a length.

The **\$75,000 Kip Deville Stakes** was taken by **Bayerd** by one length. With a 3-5 favorite, he certainly kept his fans happy. Bayerd took the win with Rosie Napravnik on his back. He is owned by Clark Brewster and trained by Steve Asmussen. Owned and trained by C.R. Trout, **Fast N Fine Lookin** took the win in the **\$50,000 Flashy**

Lady Stakes. Jockey Jareth Loveberry ran Fast N Fine Lookin fast enough to take the win by 3-3/4 lengths.

Ridgeofstone rallied from midpack in the **\$50,000 Ladies on the Lawn Stakes** to win the 7-1/2 furlong turf race under jockey Jareth Loveberry. Owned by Al and Bill Ulwelling and trained by Michael Biehler, Ridgeofstone finished the race in 1:28.19.

Tonito M. paid out \$12.80 to win. Shanon Nicole returned \$7.40 to win. Greengrassofyoming gave back \$19.20 for the win. Mico Margarita paid \$4.80 to win. Bayerd gave his fans \$3.20 to win. Fast N Fine Lookin returned \$13.10 to win. Ridgeofstone gave back \$10 for the win.

HOW MUCH CAN AN ACCREDITED OKLAHOMA-BRED EARN?

As much as \$3.2 million has been paid in one year to owners, breeders, and stallion owners of accredited Oklahoma-Bred horses. Oklahoma state law provides for the incentive funds and prescribes the purposes for which the money will be paid out by the Commission. Owners, breeders, and stallion owners have earned in excess of \$38 million from the inception of the program in 1984.
