325:60-1-8. USE OF EQUIPMENT

No bridle shall weigh more than two pounds, nor shall any whip weigh more than one pound or more than thirty-one inches (31") in length. No whip shall be used unless it shall have affixed to the end thereof a leather "popper". All whips are subject to inspection and approval by the Stewards. Blinkers are not to be placed on the horse until after the horse has been identified by the Horse Identifier, except with permission of the Stewards. Approval from the stewards or their designee for any change of equipment must be obtained prior to entry.

Owned by Dennis Foster and trained by Danny Pish, Got Shades rallied wide in the back stretch during race 8 on October 1 at Remington Park. Got Shades started the race near the back under jockey Luis Quinonez, and finished first by three-quarters of a length.

Jockey Jareth Loveberry positioned **Tenspeed** along the rail just in time to take the win

during the sixth race on October 2. Owned by Stan Wilson and trained by Kenny Nolen, Tenspeed showed great maneuverability as he found his way outside in the last sixteenth of a mile to finish a half-length in front.

October 3 had a night full of longshots. **Flosy Has Attitude** began the race dead last, but jockey Chya Johnstone positioned her well enough to win by 1-3/4 lengths. Flosy Has Attitude is Owned by Kim and Greg Boarman

and trained by Greg.

Owned by Danny Caldwell and trained by Federico Villafranco, **You're the Boss** took the 8th race on October 4 by 1-1/4 lengths in the final sixteenth of a mile under Ramon Vazquez giving Vazquez his third win on Saturday's card.

Z ROCKSTAR PREPS FOR OKLAHOMA CLASSICS WITH ANOTHER REMINGTON VICTORY

The \$1 million Oklahoma Classics night of racing is [October 17] at Remington Park. [September 27's] card featured many allowance races that served as prep events for the various divisional runners who will compete in the rich evening for Oklahoma-Bred runners in October.

Z Rockstar won the \$44,625 allowance prep for the Classics Cup, handling one mile in 1:37.82.

Owned and bred by Robert Zoellner of Tulsa, Okla. and trained by Donnie Von Hemel, Z Rockstar finished third behind Imahit in the Oklahoma Classics Cup in 2013.

The prep win for Z Rockstar was his 11th from 37 career starts and his fifth score at Remington Park. A 5-year-old gelding by Rockport Harbor from the Nasty and Bold mare Nasty Little Star, Z Rockstar picked up \$25,761 to boost his
