THOROUGHBRED RACING ASSOCIATION OF OKLAHOMA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicants must be a current year licensed: Owner, Trainer, Assistant Trainer, or dependant of the above mention.
- Dependants must be under the age of 20 at time of request.
- Dependants may attend an out-of-state higher education institution, but the guardian licensee must be a full time resident of Oklahoma.
- Each Applicant will be eligible for a period no longer than eight (8) semesters.

DETERMINATION/CRITERIA

- 1. Attend an Oklahoma or an out-of-state higher education institution, which can be university/trade-school/online classes.
- 2. Applicant must provide his/her high school transcript with application for scholarship assistance and student ID number from the institution they will be attending.
- 3. G.P.A requirement of a 2.85 or above.
- 4. Applicants must complete one (1) full semester and turn in his/her transcript at the end of their fall or spring semester with a 2.85 or higher to become eligible for the program.
- 5. All scholarship assistance is paid directly to the educational institution at the end of their first completed semester for the fall or spring of which the applicant is applying for as long as they meet the eligibility requirements and all monies will be used for any owed amount to the institution (i.e., tuition, books, etc.)

TRAO SCHOLARSHIPS

- 1. **GENERAL SCHOLARSHIPS**: Nine (9) \$2,000 scholarships will be made available for eligible applicants.
- 2. **OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY**: One (1) \$2,000 annual contribution to the Oklahoma State University, School of Veterinary Medicine, General Scholarship Program.
- 3. INDUSTRY EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP: One (1) \$500 grant for racing industry representatives for continuing education. This grant program would be individually approved on a request basis, (one time grant per individual).
